### CATHOLIC VETERANS APPLAUD VIRGINIA GOV. TIM KAINÉ

ALEXANDRIA, VA: Virginia's Catholic Governor, and future chairman of the Democratic National Committee, Tim Kaine (D), recently signed into law legislation that allows the State of Virginia to issue special "Choose Life" vehicle license plates, and limits state funding for research and development, "...on human cells or tissue derived from induced abortions or from stem cells obtained from human embryos."

In a public statement issued by his Communication's Director, Gov. Kaine stated that his decision was, "in keeping with his faith and personal beliefs", and that, "the Governor is opposed to using state funds to fund embryonic stem cell research..." Further, the statement referenced that the Governor would rather focus on the more promising, ethical, and current scientific trend of research into lines of adult and placental stem cells.

Today, the CWV would like to applaud and offer our support to Gov. Kaine and the Virginia State Legislature for refusing to lay down
